## Fairytale Voices

Help Felix Frog on his journey, meeting some familiar faces along the way. Listen to the different characters and then see if you can match the voices.



## **3 Letter Objects**

Explore the poster and find all the three letter words. The poster is packed with rhyme and alliteration: a pig in a wig and a hen in a hat... More advanced children can even have a go at making up the words from the phonemes at the top of the poster!




#### I Spy Alphabet

Match the initial letter sounds to the pictures. Then listen to a silly sentence for every letter of the alphabet.




## Flashcards and Game Boards


# Guidance Booklet and Video
